

Introduction to Collage with Paint and Paper

Student supply list:

Canvas board (stay in the 5x7" to 8x10" size range; feel free to bring more than one)

Scissors suitable for detail cutting

At least 4 or 5 different, contrasting colors of acrylic paint. (You can use the inexpensive 2 oz. craft-grade acrylics for this class)

4 or 5 foam brushes (1" size works best)

inexpensive 1/2" or 1" bristle brush (will be used for gluing)

at least 2 containers to hold water (ie. save up those 16 oz or 32 oz sour cream and yogurt containers)

clothes or work apron you don't mind getting paint on

Optional (supplies to bring if you have them on hand)

gel medium

matte medium

hair dryer for drying paint

foam stamps suitable for use with paint

plastic stencils/stencil brush

Paper & images will be provided but feel free to bring your own favorite decorative papers and copies of photographs and ephemera (laser print or color toner photocopies on paper rather than ink jet prints or actual photographs)
