

CALL FOR ARTISTS **The Little Show** CCC's 2023-24 Annual Juried Exhibit December 2, 2023 – January 14, 2024



ABOUT THE JUROR: Paul Burmeister

is a studio artist, college educator and administrator, and writer, living in Waukesha since 2015. He previously lived in West Bend for over 20 years. He received an



M.F.A. in 2-dimensional art from UW-Madison.

His artwork is shown regionally in juried and invitational exhibitions, and recently he had solo shows in Milwaukee, Mankato and Winona.

Paul's primary output is small acrylic paintings of vernacular architecture, begun on site in a sketchbook or from personal reference photographs.

Application deadline: Received by Friday, September 29: 5 pm

Notification of Acceptance: (on or by) Tuesday, October 10

Delivery of Works: In-person delivery: Tuesday, November 28: 10 am- 5 pm. Shipped works should arrive at the Center by November 28 in sturdy, reusable containers. The artist is responsible for the cost of shipping both ways and insurance during transit.

Please provide prepaid return shipping labels if you need your work shipped back to you.

Exhibition Dates on View: Saturday, December 2, 2023 - Sunday, January 14, 2024

Exhibition Closes: Sunday, January 14: 4 pm

Pick up of unsold works: Tuesday, January 16: 10 am-5 pm

ENTRY FEES

Cedarburg Cultural Center Members: \$25 Non-Members: \$35

All fees are payable to the Cedarburg Cultural Center and are non-refundable. Payments may be made online at www.CedarburgCulturalCenter.org/exhibits, by credit card, check or cash.

AWARDS

Best of Show: \$300 and a solo exhibit in one of the CCC's galleries.

Professional Awards: Second Place \$200, Third Place \$100

APPLICATION PROCESS

Artists should submit three sample images to be juried, representative of the artist's style, genre and craftsmanship. Artist selection will be based on the entire body of work submitted. Work submitted for consideration is not required to be miniature. (Works created for the show will be required to be miniature.)

Accepted artists will be asked to deliver five original works in the same style, media and quality as the works submitted for the jury process. The artwork need not be the same pieces as those submitted for jurying.

Artwork must be original and not prints or multiples.

Jeanette@ArtMusicHistory.org or on a USB drive saved as jpegs, no larger than 2 MB. One image per title. Image title should contain your first and last name and artwork title to correspond with the entry form (for example, JohnSmith_ TheSnowyMountain.jpg.) Image must be in upright viewing manner. (If you need your USB drive returned, please provide a SASE with postage, or plan for pick up.)

EXHIBITION & SALE

The Center will retain a commission on all art sales of 35% for CCC Members and 40% for Non-Members. All work must be priced and available for sale. No price changes or title changes may be made after entry. Following the Opening Reception and Awards Ceremony, artworks will be sold "Cash and Carry." Artists will be contacted with the option to bring replacement pieces for sold artworks. Replacement works must adhere to size restrictions noted below.

REQUIREMENTS

For 2D works: Image size may not exceed 36 square inches. (for example, 6x6" or 4x9", etc.) 2D works should be framed or unframed canvases have painted, gallery-wrapped edges. There are no limitations on frame or mat width. 2D works in any media and must be ready for display with hangers. (Wire hangers are strongly preferred over sawtooth hangers.) Works should be clearly labeled on the backside with your full name, title, medium and price.

All work is required to be available for purchase.

For 3D works: works must not exceed 9 inches in any dimension, including the base. Sculptural work must stand firmly on its own if not mounted to a base.

Artworks will be checked for adherence to size restrictions. Any works not adhering to requirements will be ineligible for cash awards.

WHAT IS A "JURIED" EXHIBITION?

A "juried" exhibition is one in which a juror will select artists to be included in the exhibit based on the sample images submitted to represent your work. The same juror will also choose award winners based on the artwork shown in the exhibit.

2023-2024 The Little Show Application/Entry Form

Applications must be received by Friday, September 29: 5 pm. Artwork submitted for jury purposes need not be the same pieces as those submitted for the exhibit. However, all artwork should adhere to the same overall style. Artwork deviating from the overall style of work originally submitted for jurying will be ineligible for cash awards.
