- Artwork should be picked up at the Cedarburg Cultural Center from 10:00 am – 5:00 pm
- All work not picked up by April 15, 2025 will become the property of the Ozaukee County Art Committee.

* **Entries may not be removed before pickup date or at any time during the show.** *

For your privacy we will not share your information with any other organization.

Neither the **Ozaukee County Art Committee** nor the **Cedarburg Cultural Center** will be held responsible for work left after the pick-up date. If artwork cannot be picked up at this time, arrangements should be made ahead of time with the Art Committee or the Cedarburg Cultural Center in writing.

*** All two-dimensional work must be framed and have wire on the back for hanging. ***

- Paint must be dry.
- Entry labels must be attached: one label on the front and one on the back of the artwork.

Adult Division

Professional and amateur artists above the age of 18 residing, teaching, or working in Ozaukee County may exhibit one piece of artwork.

1. Artists with two or more years training and/or artists who make a part or all of their living from the sale of their artwork will be considered a professional.
2. Each artist is limited to one piece of work. An entry fee of \$10.00 will be charged to each artist in the adult division.
3. All artwork must be priced either for sale or NFS (Not For Sale) at the discretion of the artist. The sale price must be indicated on the entry form. If NFS, please indicate the insurance value.
4. Commission for artwork sales: The Cultural Center will retain a share of the proceeds of the sale of any artwork entered in the 2025 Ozaukee County Art Show. The Center's share will be 35 percent for art sold by Cultural Center members and 40 percent for that sold by nonmembers.
5. Work will be insured for the duration of the show by the Cedarburg Cultural Center at no cost to you. At the time of entry, please complete the insurance form.

What May Be Exhibited

All entries must be recent work not previously exhibited in any Ozaukee County Art Show or at the Cedarburg Cultural Center.

- Oil, Acrylic, Watercolors, Pastels, Temperas, Drawings, Photographic Prints and Graphics, and Mixed Media. No copies of other paintings will be accepted.
- Sculpture
- Fine Crafts. No objects made from commercial kits.

Cedarburg Cultural Center Exhibit Policies

1. The Cedarburg Cultural Center offers art and historical exhibits reflecting our mission to preserve the history and heritage of Southeastern Wisconsin, while enhancing the area's vital contemporary culture. Community art groups, individual artists, collectors or others wishing to exhibit art or artifacts may submit digital images, slides or material from previous exhibits for review, or present actual items by appointment. The Center staff will consider issues of compatibility, quality and balance of programming in making exhibit decisions. Exhibits are typically scheduled *at least* one to two years in the future.
2. Exhibit spaces include our West Gallery (in the front half of the Center), our East Gallery (in the back half) and our Lobby Gallery (along the hallway connecting the two). The West Gallery accommodates 50-100 pieces, the East Gallery 40-70 and the Lobby Gallery 20-50. The Cedarburg Artist Guild maintains the Main Street Gallery on our premises, as an exhibit resource for Guild members.
3. While the Cedarburg Cultural Center is insured for loaned property, ***coverage provided by the Center is in excess over any other insurance available on the loaned exhibit items. In an effort to protect both the Center and owners of loaned exhibit items, the Center reserves the right to request insurance documentation and to limit the value of items accepted.*** In the event of an insurance claim, artwork is insured for its stated value on the exhibition contract.
4. During group art shows, Cedarburg Cultural Center staff works directly with one or two group leaders who are responsible for the following:
 - Coordinating submissions with their membership.
 - Conducting any associated jurying process.
 - Distributing Cultural Center exhibit contracts and securing signed copies from everyone in the show.
 - Providing photos and other publicity materials a few months in advance of the show.
 - Arranging strict artwork drop-off and pick-up times and providing volunteers to handle drop-off and pick-up and assist in show hanging, if needed.
 - Conducting follow-up to ensure that all items are picked up after the exhibit.
5. Artists may not show the same piece of artwork more than once on Cedarburg Cultural Center premises without prior consent, even if the artist is participating in multiple shows at the Center.
6. The Cedarburg Cultural Center reserves the right to decline individual items within a particular group exhibit even if the group exhibit as a whole is accepted.
7. Artwork must be appropriately matted, framed or otherwise presented and ready to hang or display in a case. 2-D art should be hung with wire – NO sawtooth hangers. The Cedarburg Cultural Center cannot store packaging materials or ship items back to the artist.
8. Artwork or other display pieces cannot be removed from the premises during the exhibit period.
9. Drop-off or pick-up of artwork outside of specified time frames is not allowed. The Cedarburg Cultural Center is not liable for the security of or damages to artwork dropped off or picked up before or after designated times. Works left behind longer than two weeks after the designated pick-up time become the property of the Cedarburg Cultural Center.
10. Artists warrant originality and ownership of the art works and that the art works will not infringe upon any copyright, right of publicity, moral right, or any proprietary or other right of any third party. The artist warrants that he/she has not used any copyrighted or licensed material (text or visual images) in the art works or in the making of said artworks without the express written permission of the owners of those rights.
11. Artists will indemnify and hold harmless the Cedarburg Cultural Center and anyone deriving his or its interest from, through, or under the Cedarburg Cultural Center, from and against any claim, suit, action, liability or expense (including reasonable counsel fees) arising out of any matter or claim which would result from presentation of the artist's art work at the Cedarburg Cultural Center or through using images of the artwork for publicity/advertising purposes.
