ELIGIBILITY

All adult artists, age 18 and over are invited to submit up to three original artworks. Accepted media may include but are not limited to: painting, sculpture, photography, jewelry, ceramics, fiber, fine art printmaking, (please no offset or giclee prints) drawing and mixed media. Works must be new and not shown before at the CCC without prior approval. Works must be available for purchase. Artworks may be taken home with buyers at the time of purchase. Artists will be contacted with the option to bring replacement works for sold items. (Replacements artworks are entirely optional.)

APPLICATION PROCESS

The exhibit is not juried.

Please fill out your entry form and return to the CCC by **Thursday, November 20** via mail, email or in person.

ENTRY FEES

There is an entry fee of \$20 per adult artist (total), for up to 3 entries. Fees may be paid to the Cedarburg Cultural Center online, or by cash, check or credit card.

SALES/COMMISSION

The Center will retain a commission of 35% on art sales for CCC Member artists and 40% for Non-Member artists. No price changes or title changes may be made after entry.

SIZE GUIDELINES

2D ARTWORKS: Image size may not exceed 36 square inches. (for example, 6 x 6" or 4 x 9", etc.) There are no limitations on frame or mat width.

3D ARTWORKS: works must not exceed 9 inches in any dimension, including the base.

the venue

The Cedarburg Cultural Center is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization. The mission of the Cedarburg Cultural Center is to enrich lives by providing a gathering place that fosters community, arts and history.

Now celebrating its 40th Anniversary year, the CCC, in the heart of historic downtown Cedarburg, has been the cultural hub of our community – the place where art, music and history thrive. From the beginning, the Center has provided access to and participation in the visual and performing arts, the humanities and local heritage. A free gallery with frequently changing exhibits surrounds the Center's performance space which features music, theatre, comedy and educational presentations. Exhibits include curated shows of artistic and historical interest and juried shows by local artists. Classes are offered for children and adults. The Center's public spaces may also be rented for events ranging from business meetings to wedding receptions.

FRAMING/PRESENTATION OF ARTWORKS

Artwork must be appropriately matted, framed or otherwise presented and ready to hang. **2-D art** should be hung with wire. Sawtooth hangers may only be used for very lightweight artworks. **2-D** works should be framed or unframed stretched canvases should be presented with wrapped, painted edgesno "raw" edges. There are no limitations on frame or mat width.

Sculptural work must stand firmly on its own if not mounted to a base. Works should be labeled on the back or underside with your name, title, medium and price.

EXHIBITION SCHEDULE

Application form and entry fees due: Thursday, November 20

Delivery of artwork: Sunday, November 23: 12- 4 pm Shipped artwork should arrive at the Center by November 23 in sturdy, reusable containers. The artist is responsible for the cost of shipping both ways and insurance during transit. Please provide prepaid return shipping labels if you need your unsold work shipped back to you.

Exhibition Dates on View: Friday, November 28, 2025 – Sunday, January 11, 2026

Public Opening Reception: Friday, November 28: 5-7 pm Pick up of unsold works: Tuesday, January 13: 10 am – 5 pm

2025-2026 the little show Cedarburg Cultural Center (CCC) exhibit policies

- 1. While the CCC is insured for loaned property, coverage provided by the Center is in excess over any other insurance available on the loaned exhibit items. In an effort to protect both the CCC and owners of loaned exhibit items, the Center reserves the right to request insurance documentation and to limit the value of items accepted. In the event of an insurance claim, artwork is insured for its stated value on the exhibition contract.
- 2. Artwork must be appropriately matted, framed or otherwise presented and ready to hang. 2-D art should be hung with wire. Sawtooth hangers may only be used for very lightweight artworks.
- 3. Artwork cannot be removed from the premises during the exhibit period without prior approval, and drop-off or pickup of artwork outside of specified time frame is not allowed without prior consent. The CCC is not liable for the security of or damages to artwork dropped off or picked up before or after designated times. Works left behind longer than two weeks after the designated pick-up time become the property of the CCC and may be used, sold or disposed of at the CCC's discretion.

- 4. Artists warrant originality and ownership of the art works and that the art works will not infringe upon any copyright, right of publicity, moral right, or any proprietary or other right of any third party. The artist warrants that he/she has not used any copyrighted or licensed material (text or visual images) in the art works or in the making of said artworks without the express written permission of the owners of those rights.
- No sexually explicit nudity, foul language or violent imagery will be accepted as part of the exhibit. The CCC retains the right to reject any works it deems inappropriate for community display.
- 6. Artists will indemnify and hold harmless the Cedarburg Cultural Center and anyone deriving his or its interest from, through or under the CCC, from and against any claim, suit, action, liability or expense (including reasonable counsel fees) arising out of any matter or claim which would result from presentation of the artist's artwork at the CCC or through using images of the artwork for publicity/advertising purposes.
- Artists agree to the use of their artwork and/or their names and likeness in any promotional materials published to promote this exhibit or any future events or exhibits.
