

Accepted Media

Accepted media may include but are not limited to painting, sculpture, photography, jewelry, ceramics, fiber, printmaking, assemblage, collage, drawing and mixed media.

There is no size limit. Works must be new and not shown before at the CCC without prior approval.

Each artist, family or group may submit one original artwork. (Individual artist names may not appear in group entries if already entered as an Individual.)

No Entry Fees

There is no entry fee to participate in the exhibit, but the non-profit Center welcomes any free will donations of your choosing.

Sales/Commission

If you choose to offer your work for sale, the Center will retain a commission of 35% on art sales for CCC Member artists and 40% for Non-Member artists.

Framing/Presentation of Artworks

As this is a special community project exhibit, no special framing requirements are being put forth. Please make sure that any hanging hardware can support the weight of your artwork and any framing materials used to present it. Please include your name(s) and title of your artwork on the back or underside of the work.

Awards

Awards will be presented in each category.

- Youth: ages 17 & under...
- Adults: ages 18 & up
- Families/Groups: any combination of more than 1 individual, regardless of ages

Works left behind longer than two weeks after the designated pick-up time become the property of the CCC and may be disposed of or reused in any way the CCC deems appropriate.
- 4. Artists warrant originality and ownership of the art works and that the art works will not infringe upon any copyright, right of publicity, moral right, or any proprietary or other right of any third party. The artist warrants that he/she has not used any copyrighted or licensed material (text or visual images) in the art works or in the making of said artworks without the express written permission of the owners of those rights.
- No sexually explicit nudity, foul language or violent imagery will be accepted as part of the exhibit, the CCC retains the right to reject any works it deems inappropriate for community display.
- 6. Artists will indemnify and hold harmless the Cedarburg Cultural Center and anyone deriving his or its interest from, through or under the CCC, from and against any claim, suit, action, liability or expense (including reasonable counsel fees) arising out of any matter or claim which would result from presentation of the artist's artwork at the CCC or through using images of the artwork for publicity/advertising purposes.
- 7. Artists agree to the use of their artwork and/or their names and likeness in any promotional materials published to promote this exhibit or any future events or exhibits.
